The Cost of Sexual Violence

\$241,600 lifetime income loss
Emergency medical care can cost
almost \$2000
1 out of 50 students who experience
sexual violence
lost 1 semester of tuition,
which cost an average of \$5,150,
totaling nearly \$2 billion nationally.
