We are a multicultural organization whose mission is grounded in social justice and to ending intersecting forms of oppression and violence. CHH currently seeks a Full-Time Community Impact Manager. This position is responsible for working towards achieving long-lasting, meaningful community change and community impact through Education, Prevention and Community Mobilization.

Responsibilities Include:

- identifying community strengths, assets, issues and needs;
- planning, attending, and coordinating meetings and events
- encouraging and uplifting disenfranchised voices
- developing new resources with the community and evaluating existing programs;
- building relationships with other groups and agencies;
- helping to raise public awareness on sexual violence in ways relevant to the community;
- developing and implementing creative strategies for outreach and education;
- recruiting and training staff, interns, and volunteers;

Basic Requirements:

- Master's Degree in field of social work, psychology, community organizing, violence prevention or comparable lived experience.
- 5+ years' experience in the health and social service field
- 2 years in program management/supervision
- Demonstrated experience developing and implementing culturally relevant programs for diverse cultural and linguistic populations
- Capability to take a leadership role with non-profit agencies, volunteers, and staff while working with high level of self-direction with results-oriented approach
- Expertise in program evaluation, outcomes, and measurement systems
- Ability to work evenings and weekends as needed
- Experience with group presentations, providing training and technical assistance

Preferred Qualifications:

- Dynamic community organizer, able to transfer knowledge to staff
- Excellent public speaking, presentation skill, and communication skills both verbal/written
- Bilingual in Spanish, Khmer and/or Portuguese, highly desired
- Trained RCC Counselor or ability to begin Rape Crisis Counselor training within 1 month of hire
