Community Engagement Specialist Position Available

This new position is responsible for implementing the community engagement work of the RICADV, supporting the work of the RICADV's task force of survivors (SOAR), and providing training and technical assistance to affiliate and full member agencies. This position is full time and reports directly to the Director of Community Engagement.

Specific responsibilities include the following:

- Build relationships and strengthen collaborations with ally organizations, focusing on marginalized communities
- Work in partnership with the SOAR (Sisters Overcoming Abusive Relationships) Coordinator to provide logistical support during monthly meetings and events; organize, provide training for, and support SOAR as needed
- Oversee the intern program, including recruitment, training and supervision
- Work with member agencies and affiliate members to provide training, support, monitoring, and technical assistance
- Assist in the development of RICADV's training calendar

Requirements:

Three years' experience in domestic violence prevention/advocacy, or comparable experience; excellent communication, planning, organizational, and interpersonal skills; strong skills as a trainer; ability to take initiative, work independently, and work as part of a team
