- Teaches sex education to adults and teens with intellectual disabilities
- Provides 1 on 1 educational supports in healthy relationships, sex education, and safety and self-defense skills to adults and teens with intellectual disabilities
- Travels to schools, disability service agencies, and other locations to teach classes
- Conducts community outreach to educate stakeholders and potential collaborators about the IMPACT:Ability program
- Assists the IMPACT:Ability Manager and IMPACT Assistant Director with program logistics and scheduling
- Creates curriculum materials, handouts and other documents needed for IMPACT:Ability program
