Community Organizer/Youth Advocate (August 2017)

This position is responsible for working on focused community mobilization efforts, particularly related to reducing sexual violence in the lives of children and youth and on working with schools and college campuses.

- Conduct outreach to youth serving organizations in the Greater Lowell area
- Provide training to youth serving providers on sexual violence
- Provide psychoeducation and advocacy to youth, both survivors and non
- Train hotline volunteers to answer the Youth crisis line
- Establish a Web based referral and/or chat services project
- Analyze evaluation results for each training and adjust curriculum as needed

Basic Requirements:

- Bachelor's Degree in related field (i.e social work, sociology, psychology, community organizing)
- 1-3 years' experience working with youth and/or adults who work with youth
- Training experience (youth and/or adult) is required.
- Experience working at a youth serving organization or in a prevention program
- Experience developing and implementing culturally relevant programs and services for diverse cultural and linguistic populations.
- Excellent presentations skill and communication skills both verbal/written.
- Ability to work evenings and weekends as necessary
- Must be RCC trained or willing to be trained within three months of employment.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Bilingual in Spanish, Khmer or Portuguese, highly desired
- Lived experience
- Good relational and public speaking skills, writing skills, and a passion for social justice and change.
- Candidate should have basic familiarity with using Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and Publisher.
- Knowledge of social media and web design is a plus.
- Bilingual in Spanish, Khmer and/or Portuguese, highly desired
- Trained RCC Counselor or ability to begin Rape Crisis Counselor training within 1 month of hire
