Domestic Violence Homicides in Massachusetts

January 1, 2025, to Present (as of September 11, 2025)

June 13, 2025: Rose “Jessy” Lamour, 25, of Milton, was found at home with knife wounds, apparently inflicted by Stanley Monteperousse, 35, who appeared to have taken his own life. They are survived by their child. Rose was born in Haiti and pursued a degree in Legal Sciences at Gonaives School of Human Rights before coming to the United States. She worked as a dance teacher and school secretary. Rose loved cooking, music, beauty and fashion, and played violin. Those close to her describe her work ethic, artistic soul, charismatic charm, and the love she had for her family.

June 18, 2025: Yoraily Santos, 18, of Brockton was allegedly shot and killed by her boyfriend Starli Roa Tayeras, 22, who also killed himself. Neighbors told law enforcement that there had been a history of domestic violence. According to social media, Yoraily was born in the Dominican Republic.

June 30, 2025: Rose Lacroix, of Mattapan, was found in an apartment in Brockton, having died from stabbing wounds allegedly inflicted by Reynald Biamby, 44. Rose was born in Haiti and came to the United States in 2023 with the goal of providing a better future for her family, including her 9-year-old son, Jayden, and mother, who are both still in Haiti. Rose quickly learned English, earned her CNA license and began working at the Elizabeth Seton Residence Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Wellesley Hills. Her colleagues, who launched a GoFundMe to support her brother, describe her as a woman of grace, humility, and sacrifice who cared deeply for others, including her family, patients, and colleagues.

On August 8, **Kylee Monteiro, 18, of Attleboro**, was reported missing by her ex-boyfriend, Gregory Groom, 22. Two weeks later, Gregory allegedly confessed to stabbing Kylee and burying her body on his family’s property, on or around **August 6**, and led investigators to Kylee’s remains. According to Kylee’s family, Kylee was pregnant and living in a homeless shelter for pregnant women, and that her relationship with Gregory had included physical altercations in the past. Before her disappearance, Kylee texted her sister that she was in danger and named Gregory. Kylee was a recent graduate of Attleboro High School.

August 8, 2025: Marie Hunt, 37, was found in the home she shared with Mark Henshaw, 35, in **Raynham**. Authorities have ruled that Mark shot and killed Marie before taking his own life. Born in Brockton, Marie grew up in Raynham and graduated from Bridgewater Raynham Regional High School. She worked for many years as a Corrections Officer for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Her family describes her as a free spirit with an infectious energy and creative soul. She loved to be outdoors, to listen to Janis Joplin, and to drive a snowplow. Marie leaves behind her three children, two of whom were home at the time of the shooting.

August 31, 2025: Karine Asatryan, 35, and Nadia Abrahamian, 80, were shot and killed in their home in **Watertown**, allegedly by Karine’s partner David Minasvand, 31, who died from self-afflicted gunshot wounds. The three lived in the same house in what has been described as “a blended Armenian family that symbolized the transformative power of living in a beloved community”. Born in Armenia, Karine was the first of her family to come to America and is described by her family as a deeply loving mother,

sister, daughter, and niece. She worked as a caregiver to Nadia and her late husband Sarkis, who became honorary grandparents to Karine's 15-month-old daughter Madeline. Nadia was born in Istanbul, Turkey, and spoke four languages. She was an avid advocate for the right of Armenian children to access high quality education in their native language, and she wrote and published two Armenian-language textbooks in the natural sciences before moving to Watertown in 1982.
